Try-a-Skill Days

National Skills Week (August 29 – September 4) recognises, celebrates and informs students and the wider public of the diversity, benefits and career pathways associated with Vocational Education and Training.

VET has a key role to play in the economy and through National Skills Week Australians of all ages can explore the skills that Industry needs to advance Australia's competitiveness.

Marcellin Technical College will host 'Try-a-Skill' Days for students in Year 9 -11 during National Skills Week. 'Try-a-Skill' is a free one-day

introductory program to different skills in traditional trades. Young people will have an opportunity to engage with skills in automotive, construction, electrotechnology and engineering (including CNC machining).
